**Description:** The Colorado Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) Quality and Standards team is offering training on C.R.S. 27-65 for providers. This training is designed for providers, clinicians, and 27-65 facility staff that want to learn more on the involuntary mental health process in Colorado. This training will cover updates to statute and M forms, emergency mental health holds, patient rights, clinical documentation of M-1's. This training will also include an overview of the involuntary process, and give providers space to ask specific questions regarding the recent changes to C.R.S. 27-65.
