Description: November is Lung Cancer Awareness Month. Lung cancer is the second most common cancer in both men and women in the United States and the leading cause of cancer death, accounting for about 1 in 5 of all cancer deaths. This activity will discuss the differential diagnosis for pulmonary nodules, with review of screening updates and limitations. Additionally, learners will review the work-up and management of pulmonary nodules, with a brief overview of treatments for lung cancer.
