Description:

This Grand Rounds activity will provide a discussion of the current state of deceased organ donation in the United States. The session will review current national and local statistics and examine the shift from donation after brain death (DBD) to donation after circulatory death (DCD). Participants will also explore the impact of donor hospitals and Organ Procurement Organizations during these evolving practices.
